Those flagship events along with MAGICA's work plan will support decision makers and practitioners to exchange with the scientific community on urgent knowledge needs for climate action.



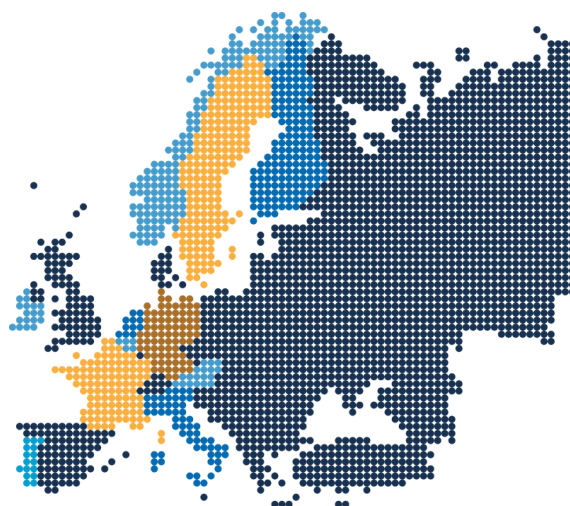

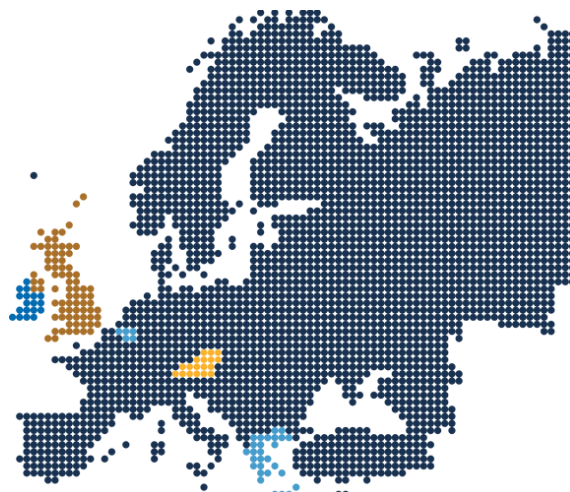
